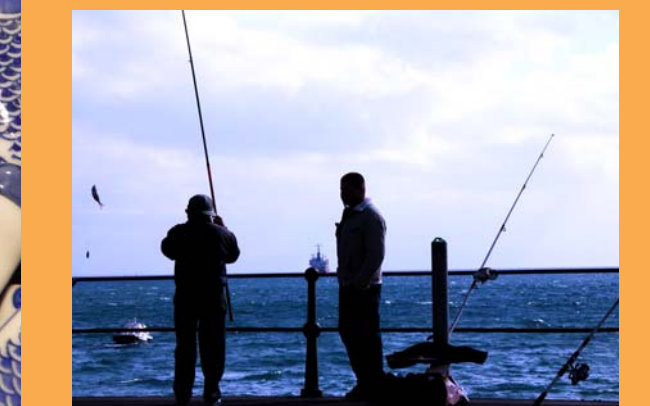
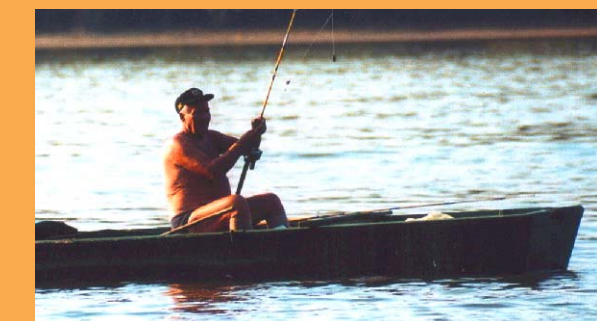
Chess
