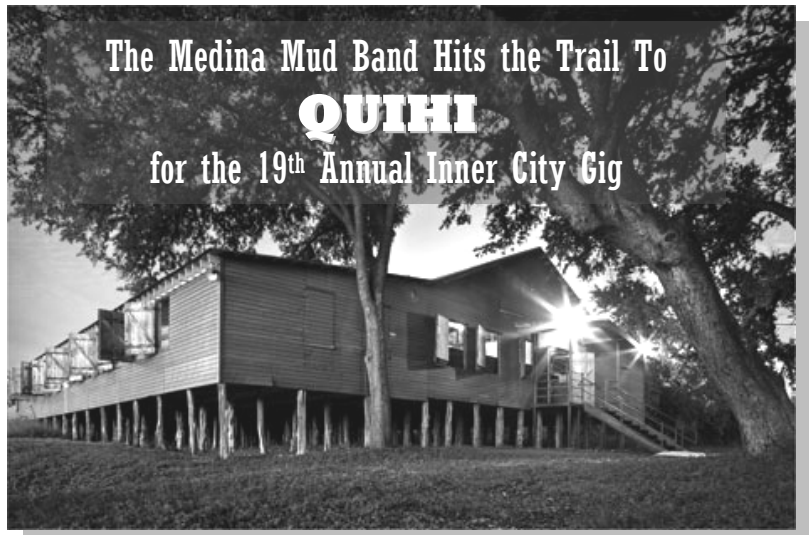


Howdy, Y'all – It's QUIHI Time again!

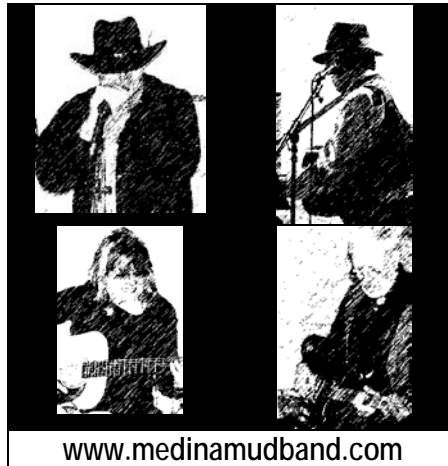

DIRECTIONS

- Take HWY 90 to Castroville (about 10 miles past 1604)
- Stay on 90, cross the river in Castroville, go through town
- At the top of the hill just past the Alsatian Inn, turn right on the road marked QUIHI
- Then turn left immediately and go 8.3 miles to fork
- Take the left fork - you're nearly there!
- Go .3 miles and look for the dirt road
- Take a right - that's it!
